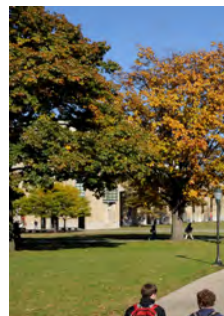

# How to get to **CMKL** University from Suvarnabhumi International Airport



## Option 1:

Take a taxi to CMKL University at KMITL campus about 15 minutes.

Show this to the taxi driver.

## Option 3:

Airport Limousine You can as well book for an airport limousine but this is more expensive but more comfortable. The price ranges from about 750-2,000 Thai Baht depending on the brand of the limousine, if you encounter any problems on your way to the university. You shouldn't hesitate to contact us by phone.



### Option 2:

Take the Airport Rail link to Laddkrabang Station, the airport link Station is situated at the ground floor of the airport. Then, take a taxi or 'Song-thaew' to CMKL University.

### Fares and Ticketing

There are two types of tickets: single-trip tokens and pre-paid Smart Passes. For temporary visitors, single-trip tokens are more suitable.

**SA City Line:** Increment rate starts at 15 baht, maximum 45 baht.

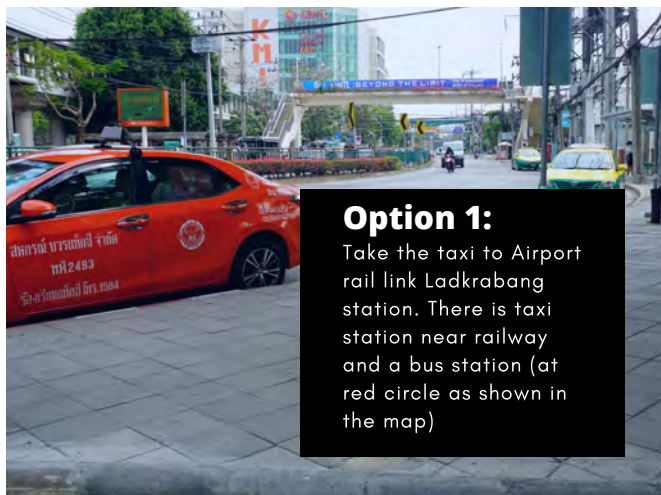


### Airport Rail Link

Connect downtown Bangkok (Phaya Thai) with Suvarnabhumi International Airport, completing each run in 30 minutes, making this a quick and convenient transport option for getting in and out of Bangkok. You come to CMKL University and get in Bangkok at Lat Krabang. The Airport Rail Link connects you to the MRT underground at Makkasan City Interchange Station (MRT Petchaburi Station) and the BTS Skytrain at Phayathai Station.



# How to get to Bangkok downtown from CMKL University



## Option 1:

Take the taxi to Airport rail link Ladkrabang station. There is taxi station near railway and a bus station (at red circle as shown in the map)



## Option 2:

Take the Public van (located about 100 m far from Pra Chom Klao station) to Victory Monument .



### Option 3:

Take a minibus (Songthaew) with tag 'Airport link' to Airport rail link Ladkrabang station. It takes you around six minutes to get to airport link (around 4.7 km).



### Option 4:

There are five bus stops within university area. Most is Office of the President building side. These following buses drive pass the university;

- **Bus line number 143**  
(Happy Land - KMITL)
- **Bus line number 151**  
(Lad Prao 71 - Hua Takhe Market)
- **Bus line number 157**  
(Morchit 2 - KMITL)
- **Bus line number 1013**  
(Hua Takhe - Phra Khanong)

### Option 5:

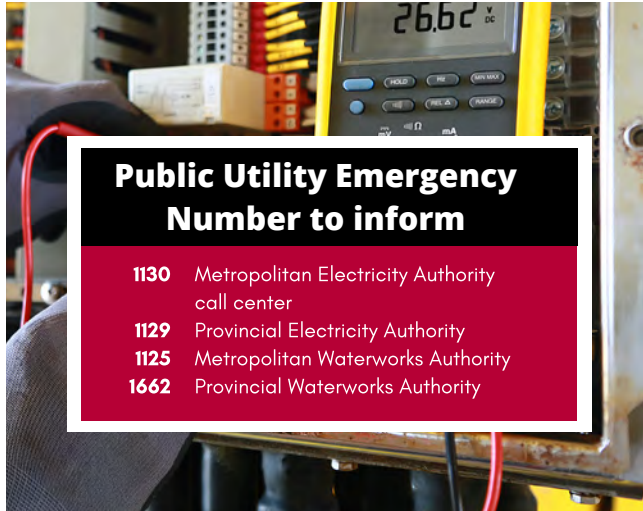
